Our Church will be open at 7.00 a.m. for quiet prayer, Morning Prayer at 8.00 a.m., from Sunday to Thursday.

The latest guidance on music in churches is that a choir may sing, but the congregation may not. In order to minimise the risk to the choir, we are simplifying what we do; for instance, the Gloria will be said and there will not be a psalm. An anthem [or short organ piece] will follow the Sermon, and the choir will sing certain parts of the setting and a communion hymn only for the time being. We will review this provision in the light of any wider developments, and at the end of the current liturgical year.

Thursday Morning Holy Communion will be weekly at 10.30 a.m. using the Book of Common Prayer.

Electoral Roll Revision: The Electoral Roll is revised annually before the Annual Parochial Church Meeting.
